Traffic calming . The Matlock Gdns/Queens Drive (part only) scheme - requires further consultation on the location of the proposed speed hump in Queens Drive.

The service road linking Porlock Road onto Cambrian Road. Consultations are completed and we hope to fund the scheme this financial year (April to April).

The new street lighting schemes in Marton Drive, Whitehouse Road & Mill Lane . All completed.

The new Carlton Ave play area was a very long term project which burnt the midnight oil to make it a reality. We thank the Billingham West Residents Association for their support.

The new bollards in Wolviston Mill Lane are much appreciated by walkers and, most importantly, they have stopped the appalling vehicle damage to the grass verges!
